Applying as a Transfer Applicant to the Nursing Science Major at UCI

The following prerequisites must be completed with a grade of C of higher if taken at UCI, or a grade of B or higher if taken outside of UCI. All prerequisites courses must be complete within the last 5 years.

NOTE: You can take a maximum of 3 prerequisite courses in the Summer prior to Fall start, after admission. If admitted, the courses will need to be completed and passed with a B or better (if taken at a community college) or a C or better (if taken at UCI) in order to stay in the major.
